I LOVE LITTLE PUSSY

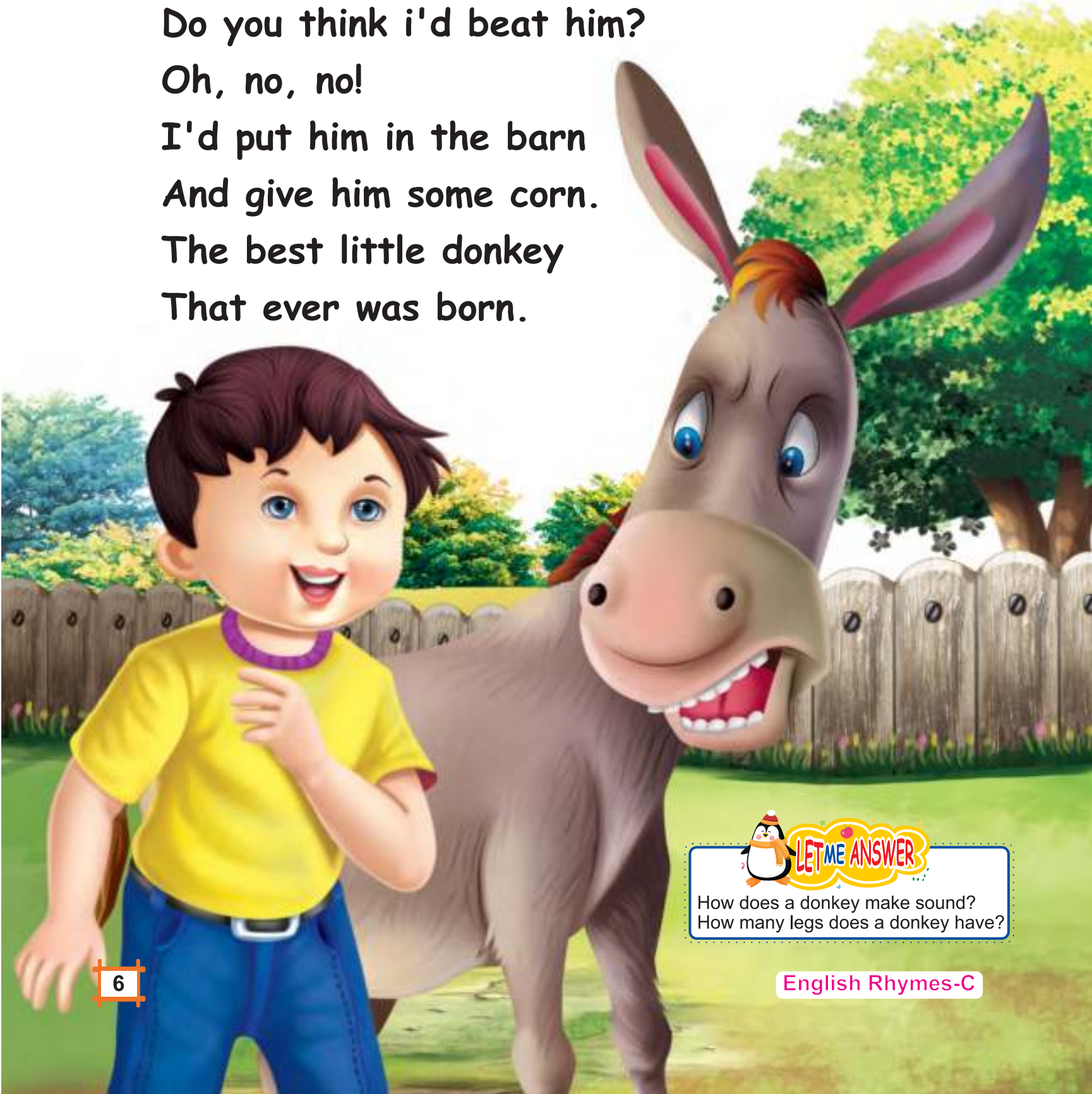
I love little pussy,

Where is the moon located?

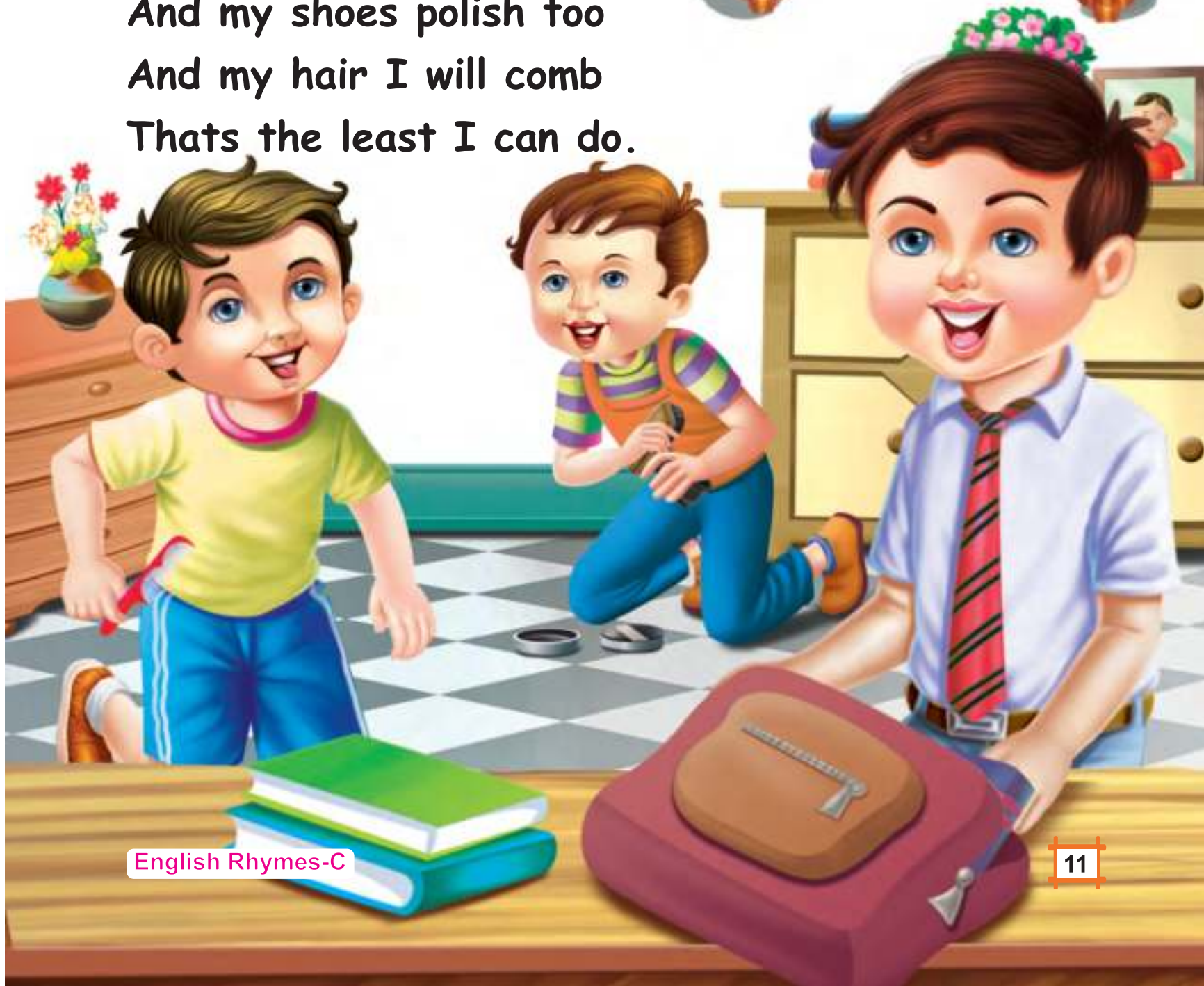
THE LEAST I CAN DO
